## III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING HELD July 12, 2011

Mr. Gierut called for the approval of the minutes from the July 12, 2011 meeting. Member Sadlowski moved to approve the minutes of the July 12, 2011 meeting. Member Anderson seconded. The Board passed the motion unanimously, by a voice vote.

## 1. <u>Case No. L-CA-10-045</u>

International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Local 700/City of Chicago

General Counsel Post reviewed the issues presented by the appeal and recommended that the Board affirm the Executive Director's partial dismissal. After discussion, Member Sadlowski moved to accept General Counsel Post's recommendation to affirm the partial dismissal. Member Anderson seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

#### VI. OTHER BOARD MATTERS

Executive Director Brosnan presented the fiscal report, reviewing in detail the general ledger sheet and the disbursement record. The Chair and Members then discussed and questioned various aspects of the fiscal report. Executive Director Brosnan addressed their concerns. Thereafter, Executive Director Brosnan updated the Board as to the status of legislation that could affect the agency. After a short discussion regarding whether there was a need for executive session, the Board concluded that it was unnecessary at this time.
