

To the Governor of the State of Illinois, the President of the Illinois Senate, the Speaker of the Illinois House, the Minority Leader of the Illinois Senate, and the Minority Leader of the Illinois House:

Section 6.1(r) of the Illinois Police Training Act, 50 ILCS 705/1 (2010), as amended, requires the Executive Director of the Illinois Labor Relations Board to prepare and submit reports semi-annually, to the Governor of the State of Illinois, the President of the Illinois Senate, the Speaker of the Illinois House, the Minority Leader of the Illinois Senate, and the Minority Leader of the Illinois House, regarding the activities of the Illinois Labor Relations Board in connection with its responsibilities pursuant to the Illinois Police Training Act, as to the following categories:
